POSITION DESCRIPTION

Through the collaboration of IBBL with the *Laboratoire National de Santé (LNS)*, you will be responsible for evaluation of tissues specimens for both diagnostic and research purposes. You will participate on one hand in daily diagnostic work at the LNS and on the other hand in research through collecting samples for the IBBL tissues collections.

Your main responsibilities will be to:

- Perform comprehensive surgical pathology to ensure diagnosis with a good understanding of analytic steps.
- Correct identification, handling and processing of the tissue specimens for the IBBL research at the LNS, using IBBL procedures and quality management.
- Develop and implement procedures for tissue microarray construction, design and analysis and manage quality control of TMAs at the IBBL.
- Optimize molecular assay protocols and novel antibodies/probes using TMA slides.
- Develop relationships with surgeons, oncologists and others physicians at collection sites to bolster IBBL's interactions with the clinical community, focusing on tumor board meetings.
- In collaboration with clinical researchers and IBBL investigators, design assay strategies to validate candidate biomarkers.
- Collaborate in research projects with other IBBL pathologists, inside and outside Luxembourg.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS

- You have a MD specialized with Board Certification in Surgical Pathology and min 2 years job-related experience. A PhD degree or equivalent would be an asset.
- You must be licensed to practice medicine in Luxembourg.
- You have advanced competency at lab bench skills, with knowledge in risk and quality management. You show excellent communication, organizational and teamwork skills and a demonstrated ability for independent and critical thinking.
- Experience and understanding of molecular pathology, expertise in histopathology and telepathology would be assets.
- You are fluent in English and French; additional fluency in German or Luxembourgish would be preferred.
