## Pathology Assistant for grossing (macroscopist)

### POSITION DESCRIPTION

Through the collaboration of IBBL with a French Pathology Laboratory, you will be responsible for receiving tissue specimens and forms from the operating theatres, at Gross Room, and to ensure that they are correctly identified, handled and processed for both diagnosis and research outcomes.

Your main responsibilities will be to:

- Ensure reliable and rapid transfer of the specimen from surgery to pathology with accurate identification of the specimen and associated document.
- Ensure the use and development of standardized formats for the gross examination and processing of specimen.
- Perform gross description of the specimen's normal and abnormal features, sample and record the sites from which blocks are taken.
- Manage software used for specimen identification within the pathology laboratory and for kits creation and storage at IBBL.
- Prepare digital gross and micro photographs, involvement into the development of telepathology tools.
- Training and daily work experience in conventional histological processing (tissues processors, embedding center, microtomes, slide staining system) and in *in situ* molecular biology technics (FISH CISH).
- Collaborate with IBBL CRCs and other staff to ensure collection of samples and to promote the work and reputation of IBBL with clinicians and pathology community.

### POSITION REQUIREMENTS

- You have a Bachelor degree in biology or related field, with a pathology certification and 5 years job-related experience. You have an advanced knowledge of specialized or technical field or a thorough knowledge of practices and techniques of a professional field, with competent lab bench skills. Knowledge or experience in oncology would be an asset.
- You are fluent in English and French; additional fluency in German would be preferred.
